The five houses on the plot off West Grove, Bishop Thornton are already under construction; the plot adjacent to West End Barn, Bishop Thornton has been granted planning permission for one dwelling and the plot consisting of two fields belonging to the Catholic Church, Bishop Thornton have been rejected according to District Cllr Mr Hull as unsuitable for a housing development due to the fact that there is a working farm too near by.</p>	<p>7.45 p.m.</p>

(UNANIMOUS DECISIONS)</p> <p>OTHER FINANCIAL MATTERS: The following Financial matters were discussed: WARSILL BUS SHELTER: Councillors discussed the need for someone to clean up the area around Warsill bus shelter and concluded that since the last meeting the mess had disappeared and there was no longer any need to pursue this matter, at least for moment. (UNANIMOUS DECISION)</p> <p>BISHOP THORNTON CRICKET CLUB: The Chairman read out an e-mail from the Secretary of Bishop Thornton Cricket Club requesting the Parish Councils approval for the £705.81 that HBC has allocated to them from Commuted Sums to be spent on additional capital projects. After some discussion of the matter the Councillors concluded that they had little option but to agree to the request and while expressing their hope that the Cricket Club would allow other community groups greater access to the improved facilities.
