9.1	PAYMENTS: No payment(s) were agreed.	
9.2	OTHER FINANCIAL MATTERS: The following financial matter was discussed:	
(a)	PRECEPT 2018/2019: Councillors acknowledged receipt of the Parish Council's Projected Accounts for the remainder of 2017/18 and after discussing the figures agreed that the precept should remain at the same level for 2018/19 as it had been in 2015/16, 2016/17 and 2017/18. (UNANIMOUS DECISIONS)	7.37 p.m.
10	HIGHWAYS & TRANSPORTATION MATTERS:	
10.1	SPECIFIC HIGHWAY MATTERS:	
(a)	PROPOSED DISABLED PARKING BAY, 10 GRANGE CLOSE, SHAW MILLS - Councillors acknowledged receipt of a number of objections to the proposed disabled parking bay from residents of Grange Close, further discussed the Parish Council's views sent to the NYCC regarding the parking bay and NYCC's subsequent comments. A final decision will be made by NYCC regarding the proposed parking bay at a meeting that has yet to be arranged.	
(b)	POTHoles / ROAD SURFACE ETC – Cllr Mr B Baker informed the Councillors that he had had a meeting with Gordon Milne, NYCC's Project Engineer and the owners of Warren Forest Caravan Park regarding the damage large vehicles are doing to the verges and walls at the entrance to the Caravan Park and along Careless House Lane in general. It was eventually agreed that the owners of Warren Forest Caravan Park would erect all white (short) plastic verge markers at 5 metre intervals along the verge at the entrance to the Park on Careless House Lane; that two 'Blind Summit' road signs would be installed by NYCC on Careless House Lane between the two roads turning into Warsill village; that the Parish Council would write to NYCC Highways, Area 6 in support of Mr Milne's assessment of the need for the above signs due to the danger to road users as a result of the blind summit on Careless House Lane. (UNANIMOUS DECISIONS)	
(c)	DOLE BANK COLLAPSE/SUBSIDENCE: The Clerk reported that the long stretch of verge on the left side of the road at Dole Bank, when approaching from Bishop Thornton fulfils NYCC intervention criteria for repair due to the edge collapsing/subsiding as a result of vehicles such as the milk tankers and tractors passing one another when approaching a bend. The repair has been placed on NYCC's list and will be undertaken sometime during the next 12 months.
