10.1 **HIGHWAYS & TRANSPORTATION MATTERS:**

- (a) GRIT BIN AND GRIT FOR SHAW MILLS – As agreed at the last Parish Council Meeting Councillors once again discussed the need for a Grit bin and grit adjacent to the bridge in Shaw Mills. Councillors were informed that NYCC Highways had as expected, refused to provide such a bin while granting the Parish Council permission to purchase a bin and place it on the ‘Youth Club’ garden. The cost will be £50 plus an additional charge of £70 per annum for two refills in the winter season from NYCC. Cllr Mr I Gant proposed and the Councillors agreed that the Parish Council should purchase the Grit bin from NYCC as the costs involved were far less than any commercial quotes. It was noted, however, that NYCC were unlikely to supply the bin until September/

October or at best prior to the 2015/16 winter season.

BRIDGE REPAIRS: Cllr Mrs A Peacock and Cllr Mr CA Stobbs drew Councillors attention to the fact that a number of footpath bridges, namely at Cishole Wood, Lower Kettlespring and Joy Bridge were in need of repair. The Clerk was instructed to report these matters to NYCC's Public Rights of Way Department.

FLY TIPPING IN LAY-BY, FOUNTAINS ROAD: Cllr Mr Stobbs informed the meeting that items had been dumped in the lay-by on Fountains Road. The Clerk was instructed to report the matter to Harrogate Council Refuse Department.
