(a) NEW HIGHWAYS PARISH PORTAL – The Clerk informed the meeting that NYCC had introduced a new Parish Portal on the internet for the purpose of reporting Highway problems such as potholes, broken streetlights, grass cutting etc. Cllr Mr Harrison stated that NYCC had been allocated more funds from the Government for the repair of the Counties roads over the next 6 years.	8.28p.m.

The Clerk was also requested to write to Mr Tither explaining the Parish Councils position with regard to the provision and costings that would be required should one or more defibrillator(s) be installed in or around the Parish. (b) CLLR MR HARRISON – informed the meeting that he had resigned his various posts on HBC and taken over Cabinet responsibility on NYCC for Adult Social Care and Health which has the largest proportion of NYCC’s budget. (c) CATHOLIC SCHOOL BUILDING – Cllr Mr Shepherd stated that the local Catholic PCC had announced that the now redundant Catholic School building would and could become a Community Centre in which case it would be eligible,	8.48p.m.
