- (a) DOLE BANK, ROAD REPAIR – The Chair Cllr Mr B Baker read an e-mail from Highways Area 6 stating that NYCC is aware of the issue regarding the collapse of the road at Dole Bank but that it does not meet the current intervention criteria. The inspector will continue to monitor the situation and order appropriate repairs without delays should there be further deterioration in the condition of the road.
- (b) JOY BRIDGE REPAIRS – Cllr Mr A Stobbs reported that the Rights of Way Ranger has ordered repairs to Joy Bridge.
